

Official Notice of Annual Membership Meeting

The 91st Annual Membership Meeting of Rave Financial Credit Union is scheduled at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 at Rave Financial Credit Union, located at 3535 Calder Avenue, Beaumont, Texas 77706.

The meeting is called to conduct the business of the Credit Union including receiving reports and announcing the re-elections of three (3) directors.



There are three (3) board positions open for re-election in 2026. The Nominating Committee appointed by your Credit Union Chairman of the Board and approved by the Board of Directors has nominated one member for each position. Nominations for the positions may also be made by a petition signed by one (1%) percent of the members with a minimum of twenty (20) and a maximum of five hundred (500) of 500 eligible voting members.

If there are more than four (4) nominees, an election by mail ballot will be held. If there is only one nominee for each position to be filled, an election will not be conducted by mail ballot and there will be no nominations from the floor.

All nominations by petition must be sent to the Secretary, Board of Directors, Rave Credit Credit Union, P.O. Box 12849, Beaumont, Texas 77726, by registered or certified mail and received no later than Thursday, April 9, 2026. The required petition form and candidate resume' form can be obtained from the Credit Union administrative office located at 3535 Calder Avenue, Suite 200, Beaumont, Texas 77706.



The Nominating Committee's three (3) re-election nominees listed below meet all qualifications to be re-elected to the Board of Directors:

Tony Lucenti

Mr. Lucenti was employed by ExxonMobil Refinery for 31 years and retired in 2009, five (5) of those years at the Mobil Refinery in Buffalo, New York, and the remainder in Beaumont. He has served as a Credit Union director for 27 years and is currently serving as 2nd Vice Chair. Additionally, he chairs the Salary, Budget, ALCO and Finance committees, and he previously served as the membership officer. He has been a Credit Union member for 51 years. He has attended a number of training courses.

Raul "Lito" Morales, Jr.

Mr. Morales is a retired Computer Drafting Designer. His last Engineering firm employment was with Coastal Automation Service Inc. He has worked in the Refining and Petrochemical Industry over 40 plus years at multiple plants throughout the Golden Triangle. He has served on the Board of Directors for Mobiloil Credit Union for 26 years. He currently serves as Secretary/Treasurer while also serving on the Policy Committee. He previously served on Supervisory Committee, and the Major Projects Committee. His Credit Union membership is over 50 years strong.

Floyd R. Price, P.E.
